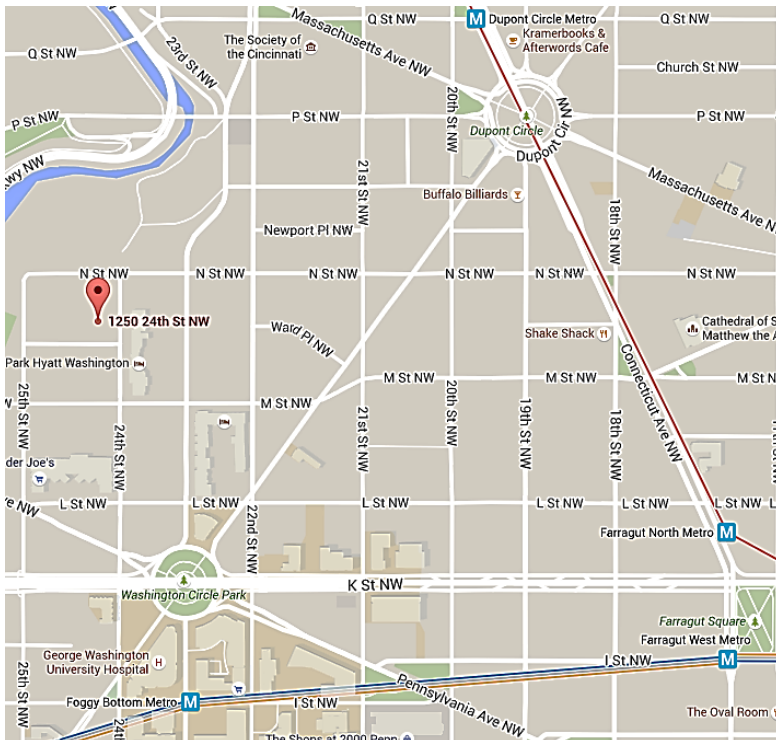

Directions to WWF (please note that costs and times are approximate):

From Washington Reagan National Airport

- *Taxi (\$25/20 minutes)*: Take the taxi directly to WWF at 1250 24th St. NW. Be certain to mention this is between M and N Streets.
- *Metro (\$3/60 minutes)*: Take the Yellow or Blue Line from the airport. Cost and travel times are the same.
 - If you take the Yellow Line, go in the direction of Fort Totten/Mt. Vernon Square. At Gallery Place/Chinatown, change to the Red Line and go in the direction of Shady Grove. Exit at Dupont Circle and head southwest on New Hampshire Ave, turning west onto N St. WWF is located on 24th St. NW, south of N St. NW.
 - If you take the Blue Line, go in the direction of Largo Town Center. At Metro Center, change to the Red Line and go the direction of Shady Grove. Exit at Dupont Circle and head southwest on New Hampshire Ave, turning west onto N St. WWF is located on 24th St. NW, south of N St. NW.

From Dulles International Airport

- *Taxi (\$70/50 minutes)*: Take the taxi directly to WWF at 1250 24th St. NW. Be certain to mention this is between M and N Streets.
- *Super Shuttle (\$30/70 minutes)*: Follow signs toward Ground Transportation/ Shared Ride Vans. Super Shuttle counters (open 6:00 a.m. – 10:30 p.m.) are on the lower level, just before the exit. When your ticket number is called, proceed outside. To arrange individual service to the airport, reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance by calling 1-800-BLUE-VAN (1-800-258-3826).
- *Bus & Metro (\$13/60 minutes)*: The Washington Flyer Bus links Dulles to the nearest Metro station, Wiehle-Reston (Silver Line). Purchase tickets at the Washington Flyer service desks at the ticket podium located inside the vestibule at Arrivals Level Door 4. The buses depart from the lower level roadway; they leave Dulles Monday to Friday every half-hour from 5:45 am to 10:15 pm. Saturday and Sunday buses depart every half-hour from 7:45 am to 10:15 pm (schedule). At the Wiehle-Reston Metro station, take the Silver Line in the direction of Largo Town Center. Exit at Foggy Bottom station, walk north on 24th St. NW. WWF is located on 24th St. NW, south of N St. NW.

From Baltimore/Washington International Airport

- *Taxi (\$90/60 minutes)*: Take the taxi directly to WWF at 1250 24th St. NW. Be certain to mention this is between M and N Streets.
- *Railway (\$15/50 minutes)*: Free shuttle bus service is provided from the airport to the train terminal (called BWI). From here you can take MARC commuter trains or Amtrak trains to Union Station in Washington. Follow the directions “From Union Station” below.
- *Super Shuttle (\$30/80 minutes)*: SuperShuttle counters (open 6:00 a.m. – 2:00 a.m.) are located on the lower level between Southwest Airlines luggage carousels 1-5 (Pier A / B baggage claim). When your ticket number is called, proceed outside. To arrange individual service to the airport, reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance by calling 1-800-BLUE-VAN (1-800-258-3826).

From Union Station

- Take the Red Metro Line to Shady Grove. Exit at Dupont Circle and head southwest on New Hampshire Ave, turning west onto N St. WWF is located on 24th St. NW, south of N St. NW.
